About Bangor, Maine

Bangor is a rural service center with a population of approximately 32,000 people. It is home to government, housing, medical, retail, financial, transportation, communications, and entertainment services for a region of northern Maine that includes nearly 30,000 square miles and only 664,000 people. This puts the City of Bangor in the center of the second-most rural Congressional District in the entire United States. The median household income for the metro-Bangor area in 2020 was \$42,115. Bangor is located 20 minutes from the University of Maine and is home to Husson University, and Eastern Maine Community College.



Bangor High School at a Glance

Bangor High School is the only public high school in Bangor, receiving students from 7 elementary and 2 middle schools, as well as from neighboring rural communities that do not have secondary schools. With a 9-12 enrollment of 1,151 students, it is the largest high school in the region, and third largest in the State of Maine. Bangor High School is accredited by the **New England Association of Schools and Colleges**.
